

### Tips for playing games:

- Teach children interactive language for playing the game
- Model game first
- Be firm / fair about enforcing rules
- Familiarize children with the names of the games to reduce the need for instructions
- Keep games in a box for fast finishers and encourage regular use
- Stop the game when children are all still on task
