Quick reminders for activities!



Louder /Softer

Hide a toy and one child hunts for it, the rest of the class say new vocabulary.



Silly voices

Use songs and an instrument and get students to do it



Story maps

Repetition, act it out, draw their own one.



Write on tables

Or outside on the floor, or UV pens, or calligraphy brush pens.



Simple stories

Create a child's book in Chinese with the following story:

Page 1. Child says "I like..." (some thing normal as in sensible sentences above)
Page 2. Monster says "I like..." (use the yukky


version from silly sentences above) Several more pages like this






